Agenda No.1: Confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting held on 11.03.2020:

Minutes of the last meeting held on 11-03-2020 was read and confirmed.

Agenda No.2: Necessary steps to be taken before eventual return to work place:

Prof. P.K Roy informed that Kolkata Municipal Corporation has agreed that they will sanitize the college premises including class rooms before reopening. The exclusive parts of the colleges, namely the Geography lab (including computers), Geography department, office and library (including computer) needs to be sanitized by the college itself. Prof. R. Bhattacharya suggested that on personal front, the college may take the initiative in sanitizing the college premises once in every fifteen days. Immediately after resumption of the college, the final year/ semester will be

having their final examinations within one month of resumption. Before eventual return to workplace, Prof. R. Bhattacharya informed that the minimum necessary work regarding taking online classes and providing online study materials may be continued as minimum necessary steps/work done by the teachers, though the final action plans depend on the teachers themselves.

Agenda No.3: Proposals for webinars:

Prof. A. Mukhopadhyay raised the efficacy and official validation of holding Webinars by colleges and on the personal front of the Professors. He inquired about the actual official status of 'Webinars' and its recognition by the Government and/or UGC. Dr. P. Bandyopadhyay acknowledging the question raised by Prof. A. Mukhopadhyay said that since the Government in its several orders has not yet mentioned about Webinars, hence it would be on the safe side not to indulge in these activities. Prof. R. Bhattacharya said, given the lockdown condition the college should go ahead in holding webinars considering the benefits of the students, at least one or two webinars in this whole period. Prof. R. Bhattacharya said since NAAC may later on raise the question on why departmental seminars or Webinars had not been held during this period, hence some might be held. Prof. P. K. Roy suggested that in spite of holding departmental seminars, it is advisable that Webinars or seminars may be held around the issue of COVID-19 and/ or the economic or social impact of the pandemic. The Principal informed that the Commerce Department is reconsidering the holding of the Webinar that was postponed as an after effect of the Cyclone Amphan on network connectivity issues. Prof. S. Mitra pressed for the immediate formation of a COVID-19 Redressal Cell which will include the academic and security issues regarding COVID with utmost importance. Prof. S. Mitra said that the importance of Webinars will be there in future with respect to NAAC and the Government.

Agenda No.4: Academic Activities during lockdown:

The Principal informed that the students of the college are accessing the online materials as has been provided to them over the last two months through the LMS (learning management system) of the college. The Principal raised the idea of dividing a class into sections or groups for taking physical classes immediately after resumption of classes post lockdown in order to maintain social distancing norms. Prof. R. Bhattacharya suggested that the above idea can be operational only if students can commute to colleges, hence it should finally rest on the decision on how much and how many students can commute to college for physical classes immediately post lockdown. Dr. P. Mukhopadhyay also informed that the system of online classes has hardly benefited the majority of the student population. Prof. R. Bhattacharya further highlighted that the last Government order said that while academic classes remains suspended, administrative work shall continue. Dr. S.Roy suggested that departmental seminars and webinars will be looked into as an activity for the teachers during the ongoing lockdown period.

Agenda No 5: Future planning regarding Academic affairs

Dr. S. Roy informed that though online classes are being held, a large section of the student population is unable to avail the online resources and online classes. The reason for the same being the unavailability of updated and modern technology as well as network connectivity issues. Regarding NAAC, Dr. S. Roy suggested that teachers under the respective criteria may sit with their respective work while at home in this lockdown period. Prof. R. Bhattacharya suggested that each group based on the NAAC criteria may meet online and draw up their plan of actions and execute them as much as possible. Prof. S. Mitra also suggested that as much as possible the work relating to NAAC and its preparations may be done while at home.
