Eligibility Criteria:

Passed Higher Secondary (+2) Examination from recognised Secondary/Higher Secondary board is compulsory.

B. A in Bengali Honours

A minimum of 45% marks in subject and 50% marks in aggregate for Unreserved category candidates, and 40% in subject and 40% in aggregate for Reserved category in HS or equivalent examination.

B.A in English Honours

A minimum of 60% marks in subject and 50% marks in aggregate for Unreserved category candidates, and 50% in subject and 40% in aggregate for Reserved category in HS or equivalent examination.

B.A/ B.Sc in Geography Honours

A minimum of 45% marks in subject and 50% marks in aggregate for Unreserved category candidates, and 40% in subject and 40% in aggregate for Reserved category in HS or equivalent examination.

B.Com Honours

A minimum of 45% marks in subject and 50% marks in aggregate for Unreserved category candidates, and 40% in subject and 40% in aggregate for Reserved category in HS or equivalent examination.

B.Com (General) & B.A (General)

Candidates who have passed in H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.

- 10. Visit the college with necessary documents for verification and enrolment at given date, as and when the college reopens.
