Annual report summary of the Institution, 2021–2022 by IQAC.

In the academic session of 2021-2022, 1186 students were admitted to the college. **98%** of UG Honours students, 88% of General Stream and 100% of PG Students have passed the University examination this year. Our students have participated in various **sports activities** and **cultural events** within the college and at intercollegiate level and won accolades for the college in Intercollege Kabaddi and Football Tournaments. The college also participated in the **NIRF** 2022 in this session.

Coming to the performance of the our faculty, we would like to share the following:

As a part of the Faculty Development Programme, **three members** of the faculty have completed the **faculty induction programme** and one member has completed **a refresher course**. In this academic session, the faculty has contributed to **thirteen publications**. Two members of the faculty were **invited to deliver talks** by external organisations. One member of the faculty has received an **academic grant** from the college for research, publication and workshop.

Four seminars, one state-level and one international webinar were conducted in this period. Two invited guest lectures were also organised in this period. Four student's talks were organised in this academic session. Excursions and field visits were also arranged by the departments of Geography, Bengali and History. The Bengali department arranged for the viewing of a live performance of a doll's theatre for the students.

The college arranged for two extension programmes in this period.

On cultural front, the college observed Students' Week in the 1<sup>st</sup> week of January. Singing and Recitation competitions were held in virtual mode.

It must be reported that due to prevailing pandemic situation and consequent restrictions on public gathering, celebrations of Independence Day and Republic Day could not be held at a large scale. However, like other years, **Rabindra Jayanti** was celebrated in the campus on 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2022.

Three MoUs agreements are in force. Consequently, several faculty exchange programmes and cultural activities have been initiated as part of these MOUs. Three add-on courses have been conducted in the departments of Bengali, Economics and English. The college also organised a six-week long **Yoga session** for the students. The college arranged for several awareness camps for **student's credit cards** and the college also observed a **student's week** in January 2022.
